

INTERNATIONAL MOTH CLASS



The following amendments to the Class Rules have been approved to be effective 1st March 2010 by the Class Rules Sub Committee.

Rule 3.2

Amendment: Add to the end of the existing rule

The sail number shall be the same number as the ICF plaque preceded by its national letters, except that the first ten boats in the most recent World Championship are permitted to carry their overall finishing position as their sail number.

Rule 5.1

Amendment: Add to the end of the existing rule

The class insignia shall be a representation of a Moth and shall conform in shape and size to the pattern held by the ISAF. Copies may be obtained from IMCA or National Authority or its delegated representative (National Association). The colour of the insignia is not restricted, except that Gold insignia are reserved for the optional use by current and former World Champions.

Rule 5.3

Amendment:

The sail number, national letters(s) and class insignia on the sail shall conform with ISAF RRS Appendix G.

Rule 5.4

Deletion: Class Rule 5.4 is deleted as this is covered in ISAF RRS Appendix G.
